

## Tŷ Perllan (Our BBQ Hut) – Rules for use



**VERY IMPORTANT : PLEASE DO NO ATTEMPT TO USE THE FIRE UNLESS YOU HAVE HAD A FULL SAFETY BRIEFING FROM THE OWNER.**

Welcome to our brand new Nordic BBQ hut, Tŷ Perllan (or “Orchard House”). The hut is available to all guests to hire for their own use, either for a BBQ or just to use the fire for warmth on colder evenings.

The hut has mood lighting and a Bluetooth sound system which you can connect to (no password). If you would like to use the hut, there is a £15 charge to cover the cost of fuel for one afternoon/evening and also to cover the extra work of cleaning after use. You can use either bbq charcoal (we find that easier) or firewood for cooking, or just firewood if you just want to use it as a firepit. We will supply enough wood for one evening, but more can also be purchased from us if you need it at a cost of £5 per basket.

To reserve use of the hut, please either contact us before your holiday or you can speak to us during your stay – please note that we can have as many as 3 different families staying with us at any one time, so it may not be available if not pre-booked.

### House Rules and Safety Notes

1. Use of the BBQ hut is at your own risk and Blaencwm Cottages can accept no liability for any injuries sustained during its use.
2. Children must be supervised at ALL times, particularly around the fire.
3. Small well-behaved dogs (up to 2) are permitted inside the hut, but NOT on the cushions. Bigger dogs or dogs who are likely to jump up at the central BBQ should be left in your cottage and checked on regularly.
4. Muddy shoes should be left outside (if not raining) or just inside on the mat if it is wet outside.
5. You must not light the fire (either type of fuel), until one of the owners has run through the safety points below with you:
  - Once the fire has been lit, the extractor fan (situated on the back wall) must be used, even if the door is left open.
  - The hut is fitted with a carbon monoxide alarm which should not sound, but if it does, please leave the hut immediately and inform the owners.
  - There is a gauntlet and a set of tools for stoking the fire in the hut, please take care when using these, as all parts of the BBQ can get very hot.
  - The BBQ is very safe, but in case of any large pieces of charcoal/wood escaping the central section, please use the fire blanket on the wall to extinguish and call owner immediately.
  - Please do not put anything hot on the wooden trays surrounding the BBQ. Use the mats provided.
6. You may bring crockery from your cottage for use in the BBQ hut, but NO other pans should be used on the BBQ. If you want to cook something in a pan, please ask owners and we can provide something suitable. All crockery should be returned to your cottage to be cleaned by you. The BBQ grill and utensils can be left for the owners to clean.
7. Booking the hut allows you to use it between 2pm and 10.30pm – please try not to make too much noise when leaving, as other guests may be sleeping.
8. Please text the owners (numbers below) once you have finished in the hut, so that we can ensure the fire is properly extinguished and lights are turned out.
